Sleep medicine:

- 1. Describe the different types of insomnia, their diagnostic evaluation and treatment options.
- Describe the signs and symptoms that would prompt an internist to consider the diagnosis of the sleep-related breathing disorders: obstructive sleep apnea and central sleep apnea. Know how to make the diagnosis of these disorders and the treatment options for these dsorders.

- 4. Define and describe the other sleep disorders including parasomnias, REM behavior disorder, and Circadian rhythm disorders.

Solitary Pulmonary Nodule:

- 3. Describe the radiologic features suggestive of a benign lesion vs. a malignant lesion.
- 4. Describe the patient characteristics that increase the risk of a nodule being malignant.
- 5. Discuss the indication for PET/CT in the evaluation of a pulmonary nodule.
- 6. Describe the management algorithm of patients with nodules < 8mm or >8mm.
